ANIMAL NOISE BIOGRAPHY

The experimental alt-rock trio from Colchester, SE England come with their own unique blend of raw and high energy soundscapes, born out of the question:

How big a wall of sound can three people create?

Theirs is a music that aims for the whole body, while equally fascinating the mind.

The band continuously and carefully craft a sound for you to lose yourself in both live and on record, with their releases catching the attention of BBC Introducing early on by Tom Robinson championing their debut single 'Baddow', eventually achieving 'Introducing Song of the Week' on BBC Radio 1. Follow up releases have had the regular support of BBC Radio 6music, Radio X and BBC Introducing, fondly airing the band's latest offerings as their sound continues to morph, expand and evolve.

Blistering live performances have gained them a loyal fanbase, with the band playing from start to finish with intense, unapologetically ferocious energy. They've graced the stage of major festivals and venues including Green Man, Bestival, T in the Park, BST Hyde Park, Shambala, Boardmasters, Blue Dot and The Hammersmith Apollo.

WHAT'S NEW

For the recording of their latest album 'Instincts', Animal Noise have joined forces with singer/producer and fellow hometown musician Michael Hemmings, from the hotly-tipped 'Rubber Jaw' (Alan Mcgee's latest signing). This collaboration has given the songs a fresher, no-holds-barred approach, with the songwriting styles of Hemmings and Animal Noise blending in unison.

Working from the intimate setting of a home studio has been integral in fostering the band's unique and natural sound. The ability to really spend time letting each song breathe and grow has been key in transforming the songs and ideas into a full flowing listening experience.

This recording and writing process has nurtured their organic and earthy sound, amalgamating it with layers of contemporary production to create an immediate, long-lasting and impactful body of experimental indie. Mixed by George Perks (Maximo Park, Mallory Knox, Black Peaks), 'Instincts' is set for release Summer 2019.

NOTES

Animal Noise are: Josh Sandifer on guitars and vocals, Nathan Marley on drums, and Matthew Hailes on bass and vocals. Singer Josh is from a small beach village in Suffolk called Waldringfield, Nathan and Matt are from Colchester, where they all met in and around the local music scene.

Upon forming, the band practiced on a farm in an old converted milking parlour. Bunkered down in a rural setting there was no one for miles around, so the band have always been able to write together as loudly as possible and with no time restraints. This unrestricted freedom has helped their creative flow and allowed Animal Noise to spend more time on honing their craft and nurturing their unique sound.
